

Pryer rules at Eton

HELEN Pryer shared the top prize from the UK Challenge Final with victory in the women's 200m on Saturday.

The Windsor, Slough, Eton & Hounslow athlete set a stadium record of 23.67 seconds at the Thames Valley Athletics Centre at the end of a long but successful UK Challenge series.

"I was really pleased," said Pryer. "I would have liked to have gone under my PB of 23.50, because that would have meant a little bit more money but I'm still pleased with what I've achieved today — it's fantastic to break the track record and it's something I've really enjoyed
